Theme

Road Safety

This week the children in Sunshine room will be learning about road safety. The children will be visited by Hertfordshire county council road safety team. They will practice keeping safe outside in the learning area using a zebra crossing and our bikes.

Our Flexi 1 and Am children will also have their Fire Brigade visit this week.

Phonics this week

Each week the children take part in phonics sessions. This week they are concentrating on phase 1, oral blending and segmenting.

They will be sound talking words using talking toys.

What we are learning.

Each week the children take part in four adult led activities to support their learning..

Activity 1

The children will be learning about book features such as the blurb and spine of a book. They will read the story of "Look out on the road."

Activity 2

The children will be practising their gross motor skills, negotiating space and moving in various ways using a traffic light game.

Activity 3

The children will be learning about and using positional language such as on top and underneath. They will play a game of "Simon says" to help them with this.

Activity 4

The children will continue to develop their sharing skills by taking part in a circle time.
