CURRICULUM - WHAT DO WE DO AT SCHOOL

• In Muriel Green, we place great importance on creativity and the individuality in children's work. While Christmas cards are a popular tradition, creating them in a production-line style often hampers the opportunity for children to express their own ideas and can become stressful for both children and staff. Instead, we prioritise hands-on, exploratory experiences like mixing colours, exploring textures, joining materials, building, choreographing dances etc... These activities allow children to develop their creativity and skills in meaningful and engaging ways, which we believe are far more valuable than mass-producing cards.
